CALL FOR PARISHIONERS TO TRAIN FOR THE ROLE OF FUNERAL LEADER

The Office of Mission and Ministry has prepared the outline of a training course for lay people to lead prayer specifically at the cemetery and the crematorium.

There will be four monthly sessions to the training with practical ‘homework’ in between. These will take place on Wednesday evenings: 14 Sept, 12 Oct, 9 Nov and 7 Dec 2022.

The initiative envisages that the Funeral Leader will be visibly present for the Funeral Mass/Service and participate in the Final Commendation Ritual. Then they will be publicly delegated by the priest to lead the prayers at the cemetery or crematorium on behalf of the parish. For further information email patricia.carroll@dublindiocese.ie

WORLD YOUTH DAY – LISBON 2023

Parishes and Individuals are now invited to register their interest in either attending WYD Lisbon or organising a parish group to participate. World Youth Day will take place August 1 to 6 in Lisbon 2023. Package options and costs are still being determined and the registration system will open in September. At present it is intended to have the option for teenagers aged 16-18 to participate as well as those aged 18-29. The Archdiocese of Dublin has a great tradition in participation at World Youth Day. A full pastoral programme for all pilgrims will also commence later in the year, with opportunities for leadership roles as well.
